

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Separate sealed BIDS for the construction of the **RESERVOIR LINING REPAIR PROJECT** will be received by the **CITY OF JACKSON, City Hall, 33 Broadway, City of Jackson, California, 95642**, until **3:00 p.m., January 19, 2012** and then at said City Hall publicly opened and read aloud.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held **Thursday, January 5, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.** at City Hall.

Bids are required for the entire project as set forth in the specifications. All work shall be completed within **30 work days**. At the time the contract is awarded, the contractor shall possess a **Class D12 – Synthetic Products Contractor License**, and must have been represented at the mandatory pre-bid conference. The engineer's construction cost estimate is less than \$110,000.

The work is generally described as follows: Construction of a NSF 61 approved 60 mil PVC liner in the City's existing concrete domestic water reservoir, and appurtenant work, all in accordance with the project plans and specifications.

Project specifications, special provisions, and proposal forms for bidding this project can be examined and obtained for a non-refundable fee of **\$50** at **City of Jackson City Hall, 33 Broadway, Jackson, California 95642. Telephone number 209-223-1646.**

This contract is subject to state contract nondiscrimination and compliance requirements of Government Code, Section 12990.

The successful bidder shall have not less than 5 years of experience in public agency work and shall have installed a minimum of 250,000 square feet of the specified liner. Bidder shall furnish a fully executed payment bond and performance bond. Compensation to the Contractor shall be in accordance with Section 9 "Measurement and Payment" of the State Standard Specifications, the plans, and the project specifications.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates for the county where the work is to be done have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Addenda to modify wage rates, if necessary, will be issued to holders of these specifications. Future effective general prevailing wage rates which have been predetermined are on file with the California Department of Industrial Relations are referenced but not printed in the project specifications.
