The Jackson Police Department has received information that a demonstration in alliance with the Black Lives Matter movement will be staged in Detert Park on Wednesday June 10th from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm. The group hosting the demonstration has been in contact with the City and the Police Department and there is no indication that anything other than a peaceful protest is planned. The Jackson Police Department wholeheartedly supports the Constitutional Rights of its citizens to peacefully assemble. However, the department will not tolerate any acts of violence or property destruction. Additional law enforcement officers from Amador County justice partners will be assisting us to ensure the safety of our community members and businesses. At this time there are no planned shutdowns of any streets and no curfew will be imposed. Should any of this information change, further updates will be released.
